

BRIEF HISTORY OF CHARLES SIDNEY GOODRICH

Charles Sidney Goodrich was born in Morgan, Utah on April 10, 1874. In 1885 his family moved to Ashley Valley with three covered wagons and a bunch of cows and a pony. They settled down in what was called Merrill Ward, They built three log houses and one adobe. Charles father, George Albert filed on an eighty acre farm in the lower part of Ashley Valley.

Then his father got a job of running a grist mill for Lycurgus Johnson in Mill Ward and moved his first wife, Eliza and the family there. Soon after they moved, Charles Sidney died. He died on February 20, 1888. There wasn't any doctor in the valley. He must of had appendicitis. He was thirteen years old. The funeral was in Merrill Ward and he was buried there.
