FUNERAL SERVICES HELD AT NAPLES MONDAY FOR GODRICH INFANT

NAPLES (Special) -- Funeral services were held Monday at 11:00 a.m., for Blaine Cardel, infant son of Karl I. and Marquerite Goodrich at the home of its grandparents. Mr. and Mrs. A. G. Goodrich.

The singing was by a mixed quartet consisting of Frank and Lynn Goodrich, Mrs. Clark and Mrs. Wallace Goodrich who sang "Sometime, Somewhere, Come Unto Jesus; also a duet by Frank and O'Donnell Goodrich, "The Tender Invitation," accompaniment by Mrs. A. M. Goodrich. Invocation was offered by Fuller Merrell and benediction by A. G. Goodrich. Byron Goodrich was the speaker.

The pallbearers were Lenore and Grace Goodrich and Marie and June Merrell. Interment was made in the Vernal Memorial Park with A. M. Henry dedicating the grave.

The deceased was born April 7, 1939 and has never been well due to a heart ailment for which no thing could be done. He is survived by his parents and two brothers, Iver, 6 and Huckvale, 3.
