

**FORMER NAPLES RESIDENT DIES IN ROOSEVELT
DAUGHTER FROM CANADA HAD PLANNED VISITING MOTHER AFTER JUNE CONFERENCE**

A telephone message was received from Roosevelt Monday, May 8, that Mrs. Maggie Remington had died that morning in the Roosevelt hospital. She is the wife of Rodney B. Remington. They used to live in Naples Ward and are well known and respected by many people of Ashley Valley.

A telegram was sent by Jacob N. Lybbert to Mrs. Remington's daughter, Mrs. Verda Lybbert, who lives in Raymond, Canada, but is not known yet if she can come to the funeral. Mrs. Lybbert was intending to attend the June M.I.A. conference in Salt Lake City and had planned to visit with her mother whom she had not seen for the past ten years. Mrs. Lybbert lost her husband two years ago, a victim of the flu.

Mrs. Maggie Remington is survived by her husband, one young son, Mrs. Verda Lybbert and three orphan grandchildren whom she had been caring for.

Several of Mr. Remington's relatives from Naples Ward are going over to the funeral which will be held in Bluebell, where the family lives. Mrs. Marion Goodrich and Mrs. Harriet Merrell are his sisters. Bishop Fuller Remington of Naples is a nephew.
