Funeral Services Held Here For Robert Goodrich.

Funeral services were held June 13 for Robert Lyle Goodrich, 20, of 62 S. 3rd W. who died Thursday in a Vernal hospital of internal hemorrhage. Opening prayer at the mortuary was offered by Fred Reynolds.
